SUMMARY

On February 14, 2023, EUSA Institute and the University of Ljubljana hosted the kickoff meeting and general training of the project Enhancing Sport Organisations and Management (ESOM), co-funded by the European Union.

Main aim of the project is to strengthen management and event organisation in university sport. This will be done through blended learning, sharing experiences, gaining new information and skills on the key topics of sports management, funding, communication and other key topics.

On behalf of the hosts, the participants were welcomed by the EUSA Secretary General Mr Matjaz Pecovnik and Vice-Rector of the University of Ljubljana Mr Matjaz Drevensek.

EUSA Communications and Projects Manager Mr Andrej Pisl guided the participants through the main project objectives and activities. All project partners were able to introduce themselves and the organisations they represent.

The participants also discussed more specific aspects of the project management, including the financial and contractual obligations, review of planned activities, internal and external communication, and specifically next steps.

Main activities and pillars include research (conducting a survey and collecting good practice), education (online and live workshops and seminars), and dissemination (creating resources and recommendations, conferences). The project primarily and directly addresses EU priorities on supporting Good Governance in Sport through promoting the quality of coaching and staff, and also indirectly by promoting Sport and Education, supporting the dual careers of athletes.

The project kickoff was also an opportunity to have a short guided tour of the Rectorate of the University of Ljubljana, as well as visiting sports facilities of the University of Ljubljana and see the approach of engaging students in sport in practice.





introduction

The MEFS was the first university sports association in Europe and the second in the world to be founded in 1907.

It is the exclusive organiser of the participation of Hungarian students in the international competitions of the International University Sports Federation (FISU) and the European University Sports Association (EUSA), the national organisation of international university sports events and the Hungarian Universities National Championships (MEFOB).

It strongly supports recreational sport at university level, so that university and college students (typically young people aged 18-28) can become healthy Hungarian intellectuals by playing sport regularly every week.





Among the events that have already taken place are the 2016 World University Orienteering Championships and the 2017 European Universities Basketball Championships, as well as the first ever MEFOB Fest in 2022.

Miskolc will host the European Universities Badminton and Water Polo Championships in 2023 and will co-host the European Universities Games in 2024.



UNIVERSITY OF MISKOLC

introduction

The university has a long history, its alma mater is the Mining and Metallurgy University founded in 1735. Our students and teachers maintain the same traditions to this day.

Nearly 9,000 students study at the university's 8 faculties, from that the earth and material sciences stand out and give the main characteristic of the institution.

We have a real green Campus close to the nature, with 7 dormitories and numerous academic buildings.

The campus of the University of Miskolc is located between the city centre and Miskolctapolca, on an area of about 75 hectares, with listed buildings and an arboretum-like park. One of the strengths of the University of Miskolc is its high-quality and diverse sports life.

introduction

The primary aim of the Sports Club of Miskolc University (MEAFC), founded in 1951, is to provide regular opportunities to students, faculty members and other employees of the university to participate in sports and competitions. It has more than 700 persons engage in sports.

The university sports club also plays a major role in the sports life of the university and the city. There are currently 11 divisions in the field of competitive sports, of which basketball, futsal and volleyball stand out. In addition, the club takes responsibility for the development of university leisure sports and the organization of institutional, national and international sports events.

In 2015, the Miskolc University in cooperation with MEAFC announced a mentoring program for athletes to help coordinate their studies and sports careers.







discobolus athlete. She won the discus throw event at the 1928 Summer Olympics, breaking her own world record and becoming the first Polish Olympic champion. three-time record holder in the discus throw, 27-time Polish champion in shot put, discus throw, javelin, high jump.



Waldemar Baszanowski

lightweight (-67.5 kg) weightlifter, a fourtime Olympian, two-time Olympic champion, a five-time World Cup winner, a six-time European champion and a twenty-four-time world record holder. He won 9 gold medals of the Polish championships, he set Polish records 61 times.



Jacek Wszoła

high jumper, two-time participant in the Olympic Games - in his first start in Montreal he won gold, and four years later - in Moscow a silver medal. In both performances he improved the record of the Olympic Games.



Paweł Nastula

Judoka, Olympic champion from Atlanta in 1996, two-time world champion, three-time European champion, 13-time Polish champion



- ✓ provides the largest contribution to the medal box of the national team at the World Universiades.







For the third year, we have been participating in joint program of preparing sports journalists at the second (master's) level of higher education in Taras Shevchenko National University (Kyiv).












