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SUMMARY

On 30 of November 2023, the European University Sports Association hosted an insightful EUSA-NUSA online meeting in form of a webinar, having as the main topic, the upcoming European Universities Winter Championships 2023, the European Universities Games 2023, EU Funding opportunities, as well as relevant updates from the organisation.

The webinar saw over 60 participants from 26 countries, representing National University Sports Associations and partner organisations.

Sharing information about the funding opportunities, with focus on funds available by the European Union, as well as sharing main points of the ESOM project was Andrej Pisl, EUSA Communications and Project Manager. The focus was on the Erasmus+ programme, Preparatory Actions and Pilot projects in the field of Sport, and the European Solidarity Corps.

The presentation of good practice examples started by Marianna Pikul, representative of AZS Poland, giving an overview of the project (Uni)ted forces to support the education of (Uni)versity sport comm(Uni)ty (Uni4S), co-funded by the Erasmus+ Programme of the European Union.

Reka Molnar, representative of MEFS addressed the participants with another good practice of non-EU funding, as well as EU-funded projects K2S-GenZ and the EUG2024 More than Games project, both co-funded by the European Union.


The online event was also part of the project Enhancing Sport Organisations and Management (ESOM), co-funded by the European Union.





SPORT SMALL SCALE PARTNERSHIPS

Applicant: any public or private organisation established in a Programme Country Transnational project involving minimum <u>2</u> organisations from <u>2</u> different Programme Countries (recommendation: at least <u>one sport club</u>)

Focused on one horizontal priority or one specific sport priority

Activities must take place in the countries of the organisations involved

Duration: <u>6 - 24</u> months

Project budget divided per partner and work packages (usually 1)

30.000 or 60.000 EUR lump sum

SPORT CAPACITY BUILDING

Applicant: any public or private organisation established in a Programme Country Transnational project involving minimum <u>4</u> organisations from <u>3</u> different Countries (taking into accounts specifics of consortium composition)

Focused on promotion of common values, non-discrimination and gender equality through sport; development of skills (though sport) needed to improve the social involvement of disadvantaged groups; integration of migrants; post-conflict reconciliation

Activities must take place in the countries of the organisations involved

Duration: <u>12 - 36</u> months



EVALUATION

- Eligibility & Exclusion criteria: applicant organisation, number of partners and countries, duration of the project, meeting registration deadline
- Selection criteria: operational capacity, partners consortium, references, financial capacity (for bigger projects)
- Award criteria: relevance of the project, quality of project design and implementation, quality of partnerships and cooperation agreements, impact
- **Double threshold**: out of 100 points, minimum 50% must be reached for each award criterium, and minimum 60 points in total
- Process: evaluated independently by 2 external experts; then confirmed by the Commission

- Application and Grants management: (new) way of submission, standardised forms
- Terminology: partnerships for cooperation (previously collaborative partnerships)
- Funding rules: lumpsum systems for the entire project
- European Sport Events: new classification
- Policy priorities: horizontal and sport specific

Dedicated Sport funds for Universities

- University model change strategy, funding and

- 3 categories
 - I. category gets max. 820.000 EUR
 - II. category gets max. 281.000 EUR
 - III. category gets max. 145.000 EUR
- MEFS is entitled to develop the criteria system and propose the allocation





Conditions

- Model changed university
- member of MEFS
- participation in various university sporting events (international, national competitive, recreational)
- 14% of the grant is fixed for the Hungarian University of Physical Education and Sport, the remainder is distributed
- In the case of the institutions dealing with specialised fields of education (SZFE, MOME), are not awarded on the basis of aptitude or performance, but are categorised on the basis of the existence and implementation of an institutional sports concept
